2020 VOTER INFORMATION ELECTION DAY: NOVEMBER 3

Election Day is right around the corner and in some states, your deadline to register is **early October!**

ReflectUS compiled information on every state and Washington D.C. to provide a quick reference for registration deadlines and basic absentee information with deadlines for 2020. The first step in women's political leadership is being an active voter! Check your status, register if you need to, and vote in every election in your state!

If you've lost your right to vote, check the last page for information on how to get your rights restored in states that require action.

ALABAMA

Register: by **Oct. 19** online (by 11:59 p.m.) by mail (postmark date) or in person (by close of business).

Vote: please visit <https://www.sos.alabama.gov/alabama-votes/voter/absentee-voting> and request a ballot by **Oct. 29**; return by **Nov. 2** (in person or postmarked).

ALASKA

Register: by **Oct. 4** online, by mail, or in person.

Vote: to vote absentee in Alaska, please visit <https://www.elections.alaska.gov/Core/votingbyonline.php>. by 5pm **Nov 2**. Return by fax or mail by 8pm on **Nov. 3**. Vote early **Oct. 9 - Nov. 2**.

ARIZONA

Register: by **Oct. 5** online, by mail, or in person.

Vote: to vote absentee in Arizona, please visit <https://www.arizona.gov/elections>. Early voting is **Oct. 7-27**. Request absentee ballot by **Oct. 23**.

ARKANSAS

Register: by **Oct. 5** by mail or in person.

Vote: to vote absentee in Arkansas, please visit <https://tinyurl.com/ArkansasAbsentee>.

Must be received by mail by **Oct. 27** or delivered in person by **Nov. 2**.

Register: by **Oct. 26** online, by mail, or in person. **Nov. 3** in person (same day registration).
Vote: absentee ballots will be automatically mailed. Change your address by **Nov. 2**. Completed ballot must be received by 7pm **Nov. 3**. Vote early **Oct. 19 - Nov. 2**. See <https://tinyurl.com/VoteMailCO> for more.

CONNECTICUT

Register: by **Oct. 27** online, by mail (postmark date) or in person.

Register: by **Oct. 10** online, by mail (postmark date) or in person.

Register: by **Nov. 3** in person; by **Oct. 13** by mail (postmark date) or online.

FLORIDA

HAWAII

Register: by **Oct. 5** online, by mail, or in person.
Vote: Absentee ballots will automatically be sent to all registered voters. For address changes please visit: <https://elections.hawaii.gov/>. Completed ballot must be received by 7pm on **Nov. 3**.

INDIANA

MICHIGAN

NEW HAMPSHIRE

NEW JERSEY

N. CAROLINA

N. DAKOTA

Register: there is no voter registration in North Dakota; eligible residents are registered.

OHIO

Register: by **Oct. 5** online, by mail (postmarked), or in person.

OREGON

Register: by **Oct. 13** online, by mail, or in person.

Vote: all registered voters receive a ballot 2-3 weeks before Election Day and must be returned by 8pm on **Nov. 3**. Visit <https://tinyurl.com/OregonAbsentee> for more information.

PENNSYLVANIA

Register: by **Oct. 19** online, by mail, or in person.

Vote: request a ballot by 5pm on **Oct. 27** at <https://tinyurl.com/PennAbsentee>. Must be received by 5pm on **Nov. 6** and postmarked by 8pm on **Nov. 3**.

RHODE ISLAND

Register: by **Oct. 4** online, by mail (postmarked), or in person.

TENNESSEE

Register: by **Oct. 5** online, by mail (postmarked), or in person.

Register: you may register by **Nov. 3**.

VIRGINIA

Register: by **Oct. 13** online, by mail (postmarked), or in person.

Vote: request an absentee ballot at <https://tinyurl.com/VoteMailVA> by **Oct. 23** and return in person by 7pm **Nov. 3** or postmarked **Nov. 3**. Vote early **Sept 18 - Oct. 31**.

WASHINGTON

Register: must be received online or by mail by **Oct. 26** or in person by **Nov. 3**.

Vote: all registered voters will receive a ballot by mail. Visit <https://tinyurl.com/VoteMailWA> for information. Completed ballots must be postmarked or dropped off at a ballot box by **Nov. 3**.

WEST VIRGINIA

Register: by **Oct. 13** online, by mail (postmarked), or in person.

Vote: apply for an absentee ballot by **Oct. 28** at <https://tinyurl.com/WVAbsentee>. Must be returned or postmarked by **Nov. 3** and received by the start of ballot canvas. Vote early **Oct 21-31**.

WISCONSIN

Register: by **Oct. 14** online or postmarked by mail and by 5pm **Oct. 30** in person.

Vote: visit <https://myvote.wi.gov/en-us/VoteAbsentee> to request an absentee ballot by **Oct. 30**. Ballot must be received by 8pm on **Nov. 3**. Vote early **Oct. 20 - Nov. 1**.

WYOMING

Register: by **Oct. 19** received by mail or in person by **Nov. 2**.

Vote: there are many ways to request an absentee ballot by the **Nov. 2** deadline. For more information, visit <https://sos.wyo.gov/elections/state/absenteevoting.aspx>. Ballots must be received by 7pm on **Nov. 3**. Vote early **Sep. 18 - Nov. 2**.

RESTORATION OF RIGHTS

In some states, if you are convicted of a felony, you need to take action to have your rights restored before you can vote. The following states require you take some form of action. Please visit <https://campaignlegal.org/restoreyourvote> for specifics on restoration of rights.

ALABAMA: If your voting rights have been taken away, you must contact the Alabama Bureau of Pardons and Paroles and apply for your rights. Visit <https://paroles.alabama.gov/pardons-restoration-of-voting-rights/> for more.

ARIZONA: If you have been convicted of two or more felonies, the judge who discharges you may restore your rights to vote. Contact <https://www.acluaz.org/en/restoration-of-civil-rights> for more information.

DELAWARE: If you have been convicted of certain felonies, you may lose your rights permanently. Visit <https://elections.delaware.gov/voter/felons.shtml> to learn more about registration eligibility.

FLORIDA: Some felonies in Florida require a petition and payment of fines. Visit <https://dos.myflorida.com/elections/for-voters/voter-registration/constitutional-amendment-4felon-voting-rights/> to learn more.

IOWA: The Governor restored the rights of most people convicted of felonies with discharged sentences. Please visit <https://governor.iowa.gov/services/voting-rights-restoration> for more information.

KENTUCKY: Some Kentuckians had their rights restored by the Governor and others may have to apply for restoration. Check your status and, if needed, apply for restoration at <https://civilrightsrestoration.ky.gov/Pages/home.aspx>.

MISSISSIPPI: Certain felonies result in a permanent loss of voting rights unless granted a pardon by the Governor or 2/3 vote of both houses of the legislature. The application at <http://www.recordclearing.org/wp-content/forms/Mississippi-Pardon-Application.pdf> is available for restoration of rights.

NEBRASKA: There is a two year waiting period from completion of sentence for rights to be restored. Visit <https://sos.nebraska.gov/elections/felon-voting-rights> for more information.

TENNESSEE: Certain felonies exclude a person from voting permanently. For other felonies, you may apply for restoration. Visit <https://sos.tn.gov/products/elections/restoration-voting-rights> for more details.

VIRGINIA: The Governor of Virginia has sole discretion to restore voting rights, however, there is a process to do so automatically. Apply by **September 23, 2020** to vote in this election at: <https://www.restore.virginia.gov/>.

WYOMING: First-time offenders who committed certain nonviolent felonies have their rights automatically restored. Visit <http://corrections.wyo.gov/home/restoration-of-voting-rights> to learn more about qualifications and the process or to submit an application.
